**The competition venue** is OneMind Dogs Arena in Haukipudas, Oulu. The address is Teollisuustie 1, 90830 Haukipudas (G-building). There is air conditioning in the hall and the temperature is around +18°C. The surface of the ring is Saltex artificial turf. **NB! Staying overnight on or around the competition site is unfortunately not allowed.**

Please participate to the competition only when feeling healthy!

All dogs participating to the competition must be chipped/tattooed and vaccinated according to the regulations of the Finnish Kennel Club, and the handler needs to have a competitor license by the Finnish Agility Association (A, B1 or B2). The antidoping regulations must be followed in the competition.

**A dog in heat participating to the competition** must use heat pants inside the agility hall and a red ribbon should be tied to its leash as an information for other dog handlers. The heat pants should be removed in the last waiting area. Dogs in heat will start as stated in the start list. **Please notify the chief stewards of your class about your dog being in heat** (WhatsApp-message or a text message).

Please inform us of possible **changes, moving up to a higher class or not participating to the competition** as soon as possible to the chief stewards (WhatsApp-message or a text message). If you are unable to participate to our competition due to your dog or yourself being ill or hurt, or due to your dog being in heat, we will return your registration fee as long as the notification of absence has been made before the start

of the competition. For returning of the registration fee send also a notification of absence (reason for absence) and your account number to Maria Kauppi by e-mail [makursu@gmail.com](mailto:makursu@gmail.com) within 7 days of the end of the competition. If the dogs in the family have been coughing, all the dogs in the family should follow two weeks quarantine before participating to competitions.

**The start lists of the competition** will be published latest on Thursday 25.9. at [www.activedogs.net](http://www.activedogs.net) and in the competition venue. Start lists will not be handed out on the competition venue.

### **Please follow the rules of OneMind Dogs Arena:**

- Dogs are not allowed to pee or poop in the hall. Should an accident happen, mark the place and inform immediately the stewards in the competition of the need for cleaning.
- Do not let your dog to pee on the outdoor walls of the hall, doorjams or the neighbor buildings or yards.
- Dog poop must be collected from everywhere.
- The use of track shoes with spikes is not allowed in the hall.
- Do not bring dog's water bowls to the artificial grass or to the matted area of the locker rooms.
- Eating and drinking beverages is not allowed in the grass area.
- Smoking is only allowed outside in an area reserved for smoking.
- Dogs must be on leash during the warm up walks.

### **Special arrangements in the competition venue**

- You may watch the competition at the long side of the competition ring.
- During the competition, the upstairs is reserved for the competition organizers.
- Keep the doorways and other passages clear. The waiting and rewarding areas are only meant for dogs going in or coming out of the ring.

- The dog crates can be placed in the locker room of the hall (see map of the venue). Crates are not allowed to be placed on other areas of the hall. **NB! Do not locate dog crates on the areas that have been covered with carpets!**
- There is a section with a carpet that is reserved for doing warm-up tricks with the dog and there is a jumping obstacle for warming up in the other side of the ring. **NB! Do not let your dog drink water on the areas that have been covered with carpets!**

### Registration at the competition venue

- The registration point for the competition day is placed at the rear back of the locker rooms.
- **Register yourself** to be present at the competition by drawing a cross to a list.
- The serial number of the **competition gift cards** was asked to be written in Kitu when registering to the competition. If you have not written the serial number in Kitu, bring the gift cards to a mailbox that can be found from the registration point. Write your own name to the gift cards! Gift cards that have not been returned will be charged with an additional fee.
- **Vaccinations of the dog** will be checked beforehand with random sample. **If your dog's starting number ends with number 1 or 5** (meaning 1, 11, 21 and so on OR 5, 15, 25, ... and so on), send photos of your dog's vaccination certificate, where the identification information and vaccination dates can be seen, to the chief stewards(WhatsApp or text message).
- Send a message to the chief stewards (WhatsApp or text message),
  - if you are unable to attend the competition, or
  - If your dog is in heat.
- NB. We do not use number vests, please follow the announcements!

### Course walks

- The course walks will be divided into smaller groups if necessary. Please check the timetable for estimated time of course walks and possible smaller groups.
- We do not start the course walks marked with red ahead of the timetable.

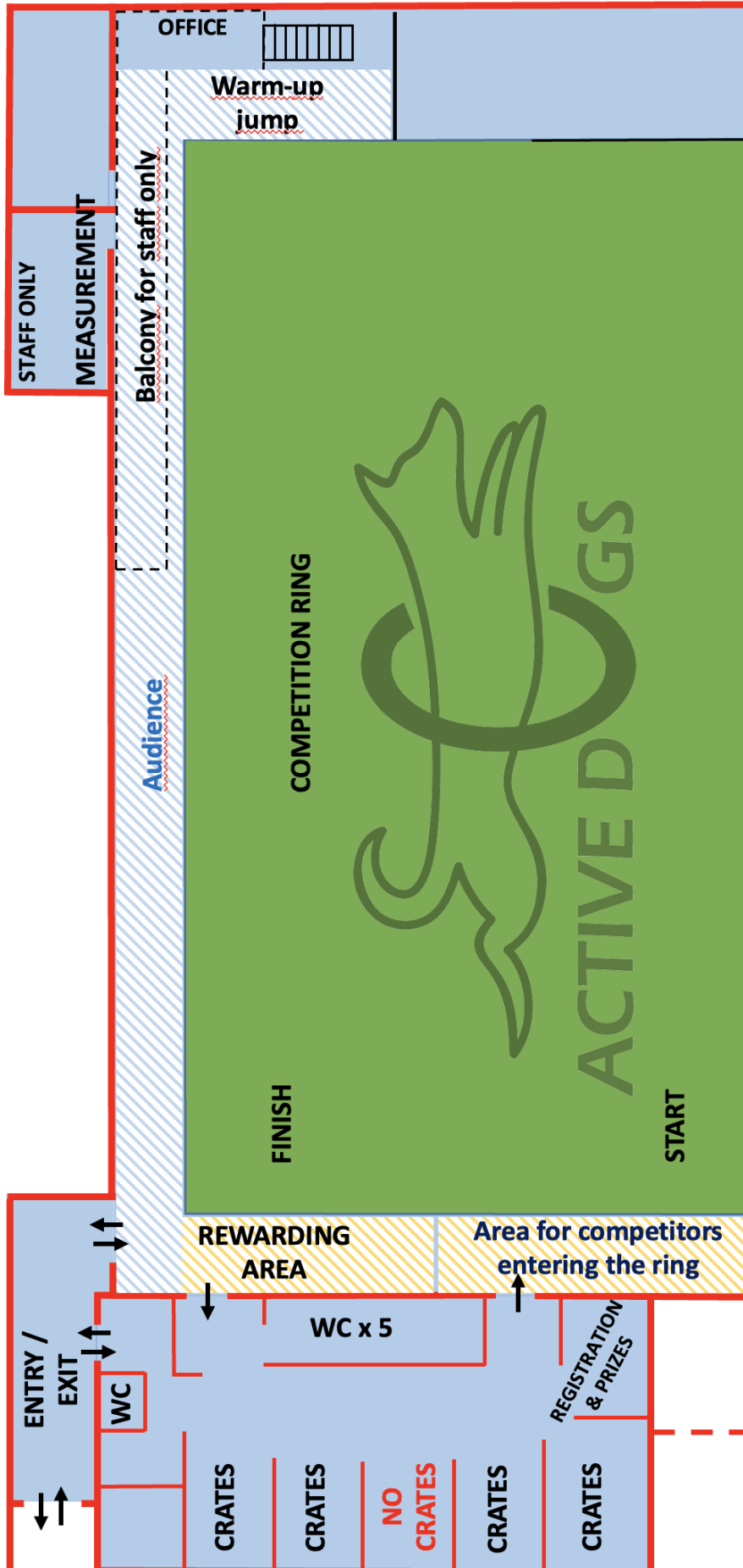
## When it is your turn to run the course

- The entrance for the waiting area is from the hall's locker room area.
- Three dogs in starting order should be waiting in the waiting area.
- When reaching the goal, the dog and handler should leave the rewarding area quickly so that it will be clear for the next dog.
- Dogs will exit the ring through the locker room area (see map of the venue).

## Prize ceremony

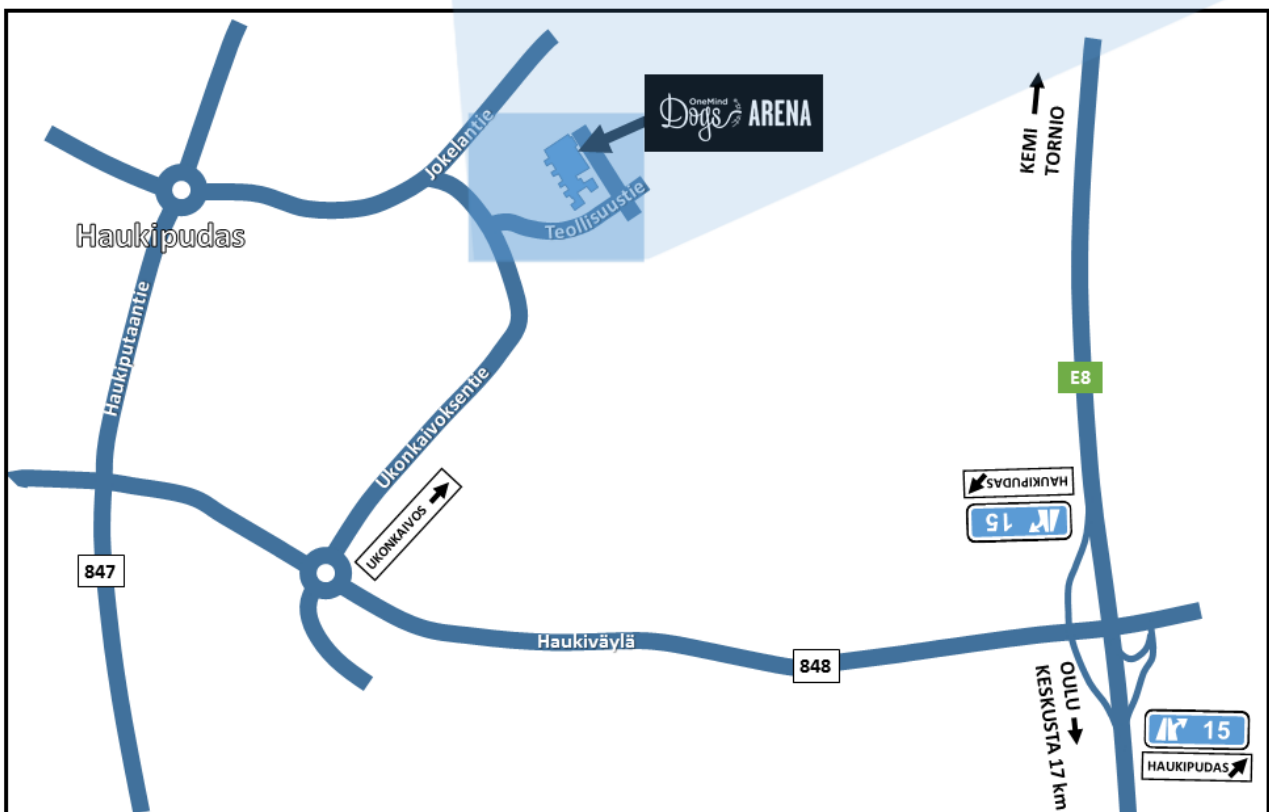
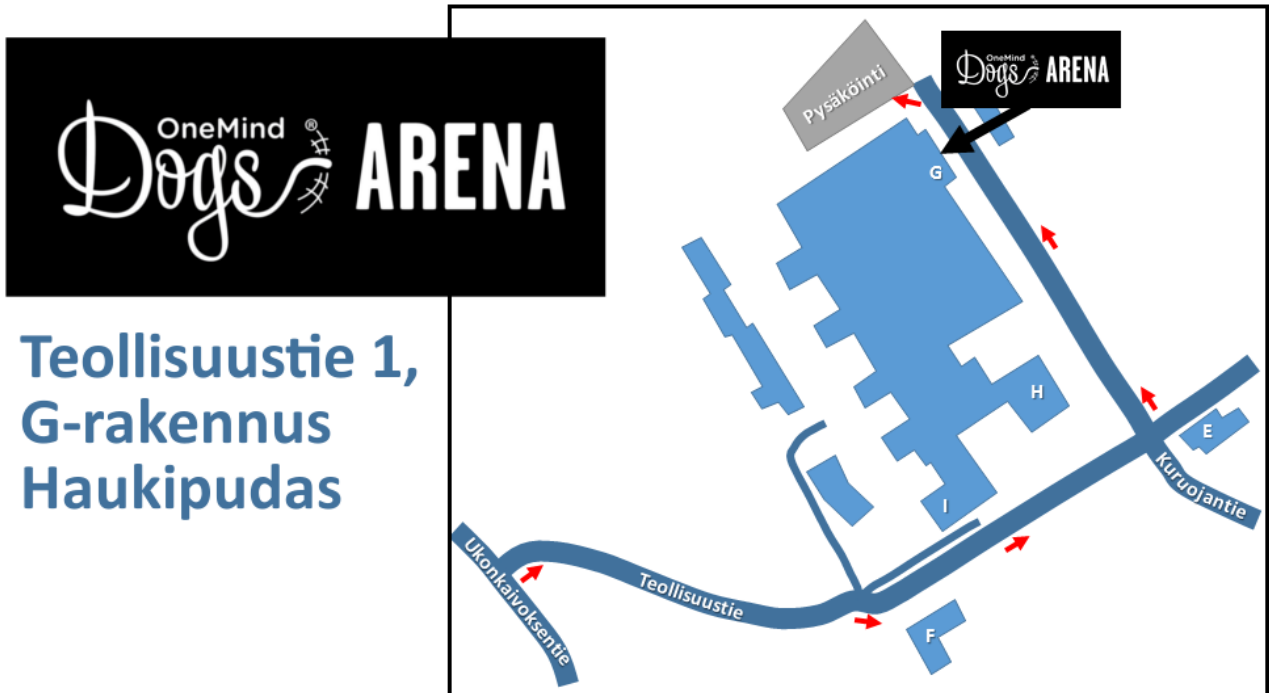
